The ESADSE (School of Art and Design Saint Étienne), ERASMUS-Partner to FH JOANNEUM, created the Biennale Internationale Design Saint Étienne in 1998 and is mainly responsible for Saint Étienne becoming UNESCO City of Design. Professor Michael Philippon will talk about the school and his own work as Designer and Szenographer.

Michel Philippon

Michael Philippon is architect and designer, born in 1950. He created the agency mpproduction in Geneva in 1991 after having spent researching theater and dance teams Jerzy Grotowski, Merce Cunningham, Peter Brook or butoh dance with Issa Myura and Sumako Koseki from Tokyo. His accomplishments span registers as diverse as architecture, achieving playgrounds and interactions, set design, urban planning. Designs for the International Design Biennale in Saint Étienne in 2008 and 2010, solo exhibitions for Contemporary Art Fund and the MAMCO Geneva Store at Grenoble, Greenhouse and Mining Museum in Saint Étienne. Education until 2010 under the Public Space Master, as well as HEPIA in Geneva as a guest professor from 2011 to 2013. Drivers of its projects is over living space, real or virtual, real or imagined by work art, set designs and exhibit architectural achievements.
